Dear Dr. Janumpally and Andrew Ormonde:

The American Academy of Sleep Medicine (AASM) is pleased to notify you that Sleep Care Centers in Rancho Cucamonga, CA has been granted accreditation for a period of five years beginning April 9, 2021. Sleep facility accreditation through the AASM includes accreditation for all types of sleep testing, including in-center polysomnography (PSG), multiple sleep latency testing (MSLT), maintenance of wakefulness testing (MWT) and home sleep apnea testing (HSAT).

The sleep facility will receive an accreditation site visit within the next year. An Accreditation Coordinator will provide available dates to schedule the visit. The facility will receive future correspondence upon completion of the site visit including a site visit approval letter, site visit report, and certificate. In the unlikely event that the facility is not able to complete or fails the site visit, the AASM will review the facility for revocation of accreditation.

I welcome your facility into the ranks of the AASM accredited facilities, which provide the highest quality of patient care. The AASM is committed to ensuring those in the field of sleep medicine provide excellent healthcare and enhance the awareness of sleep as an important element for health, public safety, and the quality of life. By successfully completing the accreditation process and upholding the *Facility Standards for Accreditation*, your program has demonstrated its commitment to the advancement of the field.

This letter is considered a private communication document between the AASM and your program. The statements made in this letter must not be used for marketing purposes. However, announcing that the program is accredited is quite appropriate. A press release announcing the accreditation will be distributed shortly.

The accredited sleep program is now eligible to become an AASM member. Opt-in for one free year of membership or review membership benefits by contacting the Membership Department at membership@aasm.org.

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Please remember to notify the AASM National Office of any changes to the structure or function of your program that might compromise meeting the *Facility Standards for Accreditation*. Situations that require notification to the AASM can be found in the *Accreditation Process and Policies* on aasm.org.

As a reminder, accreditation of your program does not extend accreditation to other programs or facilities. Accreditation of each individual site is required. Also, please note that reaccreditation applications are due six months prior to your expiration date.

Again, congratulations on the accreditation of your program.
